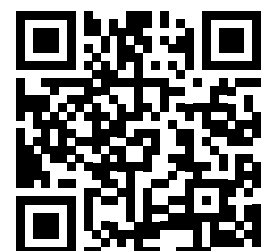

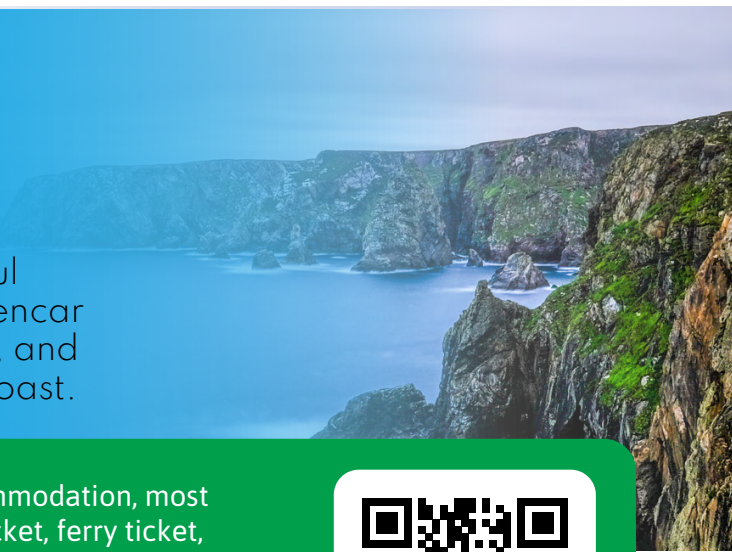
Experience a new culture
